

How to read a Freestyle/Greco Wallchart

Opponent number
In this case,
Hughes wrestles
number 2,
Sanderson

Points scored in each period. Note
that the opponent score is the
opposite. A Fall is marked with
the time, loser with an "LF"

Classification Points
3 for a decision
4 for tech superiority
5 for fall, forfeit, etc

Crescents note the
wrestlers moving to
the Round Robin

In this example, only one match remains.
Round Robin 2 (RR2) will be wrestled
with Hughes (in Red) wrestling number 4,
Jones.

The losing wrestler
is marked with an
"X" in the
preliminary rounds

A wide Bar indicates the
wrestler has 2 losses. 4th
place is awarded to the
last wrestler eliminated.

The Round Robin is setup as if none of the wrestlers has
met before. If they have met, the arrow shows a score
moved forward. Notice that actual classification points
are moved not the "X" used in the preliminary rounds.
You can score a classification point even in a loss.
