



Scorer and Timer Reference Sheet

Period Times

ALL AGE GROUPS	Three 2 Minute Periods
Rest Periods	30 Seconds
Clinch Period	30 Seconds

Greco – Each period consists of a 1 1/2 minute standing start and one 30 second Clinch section.

Signal the Referee at 1 ½ minutes. The Referee will stop the bout and direct the wrestlers to the Clinch positions. The period ends at 2 minutes.

EXCEPTION: If a wrestler is in the “danger position” at the time the “Clinch” would normally begin, the referee will continue the match and no “Clinch” occurs. (You will always signal the referee, do not assume you know the danger position.)

Freestyle – Each period continues for 2 full minutes. Stop the clock only when directed by the Referee (out of bounds, injury, etc). A clinch period of 30 seconds will occur if a period ends in a zero to zero tie. The referee will direct you.

Classification Points

5:0	Victory by Fall – Forfeit – Injury – Withdrawal – 3 cautions “0” due to error against rules
5:0	Disqualification from the competition (Infringement of the rules)
4:0	Great Superiority, a difference of 6 points in 2 periods, Loser has no technical points
4:1	Great Superiority, a difference of 6 points in 2 periods, Loser with technical points
3:0	Decision by points, Loser has no technical points
3:1	Decision by points, Loser with technical points
0:0	In case both wrestlers have been disqualified due to infringement of rules

Other Codes
Winner **Loser** **If these occur, mark the appropriate code next to the classification points. Points are 5:0.**

WBF	FORF	If a wrestler fails to show or does not want to continue.
WBI	INJ	If a wrestler is injured and cannot continue.
WBD	DQM (misconduct)	If the referee disqualifies a wrestler. Circle if the wrestler is banned from further competition.
WBD	DQ (3cautions)	If the wrestler is given three cautions “0”.
DDQ	DDQ (Both disqualified)	If both wrestlers are disqualified. Points are 0:0.

Remember:

- **Period over** - two 3 point moves, or one 5 point move in a period.
- **Tie scores** in a period. Circle the winner’ period score!!

Make sure the winning wrestler signs the bout sheet AND that you can read the signature. ALWAYS ASK THE WRESTER HIS NAME, compare it to the name you circled as the winner. The biggest single mistake made in these tournaments is assigning the win to the wrong wrestler!!!!
